

Dr Simone Becattini

Following studies in medical biology in Italy and an internship at the Karolinska Institute in Stockholm, Dr. Becattini joins the Institute of Research in Biomedicine (Bellinzona) and the ETH (Zurich), from which he obtains a PhD in Immunology and Microbiology in 2015, for his work on the heterogeneity of human T lymphocytes specific to pathogens and vaccines. He pursues postdoctoral studies at the Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in New York, where he works on different aspects of gut microbiota biology. Awarded with an Eccellenza Professorial Fellowship in 2020, he becomes Assistant Professor at the Department of Pathology and Immunology, University of Geneva, and establishes a research laboratory aiming at dissecting the relationships between gut microbiota and host immunity.
