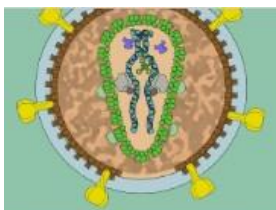

Prof. Dr. med. François Chappuis **Head of Tropical and Humanitarian Medicine** **Division, Geneva University Hospitals**

François Chappuis is a medical doctor specialized in internal medicine and travel & tropical medicine. He holds a master's degree in clinical tropical medicine from the University of Mahidol, Thailand, and a PhD in medical sciences from the University of Antwerp, Belgium.

He currently heads the Division of Tropical and Humanitarian Medicine of the Geneva University Hospitals (HUG), which focuses on the prevention and care of international travelers and on the implementation of operational and research projects in low- and middle-income countries.

He worked for Médecins sans Frontières (MSF) as a field doctor in East Africa and as a medical adviser for neglected tropical diseases (NTDs) programs in Sudan, South Sudan, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Uganda and Kenya. His teaching and research activities have mainly focused on NTDs, notably sleeping sickness, Chagas disease, leishmaniasis and snakebite envenoming.
