

#### NUMBER OF PEDIATRIC OUTPATIENT VISITS




#### NUMBER OF HOSPITALIZED CHILDREN




#### **HEPATOBILIARY OPERATIONS IN CHILDREN**












children receive a new liver 226





#### AGE AT TRANSPLANTATION 2021-2023




#### **WEIGHT AT TRANSPLANTATION 2021-2023**





## Highlights

On September 7-12, 2023, Gaëtan Bertuchoz, a liver transplantation recipient at the age of 14 months and member of the national transplantation team, and Patrick Terrapon, co-founder and president of MAHANA for Kids, accomplished their dream by walking the 160 kilometers between Bern and Geneva, together with other participants.
