MD degree at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Geneva, Switzerland, Mathieu Nendaz was certified in Internal Medicine in 1997 by the Organization of Swiss Physicians (FMH). He obtained the title of Master in Health Professions Education (MHPE) en 1999 at the University of Illinois, Chicago. He is now working in the Service of General Internal Medicine at the University Hospitals of Geneva as a tenured faculty member. Besides his clinical duties and teaching, he is involved in the organization and maintenance of the medical curriculum of the Faculty of Medicine and is head of the clinical pregraduate master curriculum. His research is mainly oriented toward the understanding, the training, and the assessment of clinical reasoning, which are the topics of publications, book chapters, and several posters and presentations in international scientific meetings.
